## COMMITTEES TO BE SIMULATED AT BITSMUN 2020

### United Nations Security Council (UNSC)

The United Nations Security Council has primary responsibility for the maintenance of international peace and security. It has 15 Members, and each Member has one vote. Under the Charter, all Member States are obligated to comply with Council decisions. The Security Council takes the lead in determining the existence of a threat to the peace or act of aggression. It calls upon the parties to a dispute to settle it by peaceful means and recommends methods of adjustment or terms of settlement. In some cases, the Security Council can resort to imposing sanctions or even authorize the use of force to maintain or restore international peace and security.

**Agenda:** Situation in Middle East - Assessing the threat to international peace and security surrounding the regions of Syria, Iraq, Iran.

### UNGA 4: Special Political and Decolonisation (SPECPOL)

The Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee) considers a broad range of issues covering a cluster of five decolonization-related agenda items, the effects of atomic radiation, questions relating to information, a comprehensive review of the question of peacekeeping operations as well as a review of special political missions, the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestinian Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA), the Report of the Special Committee on Israeli Practices and International cooperation in the peaceful uses of outer space.

**Agenda:** Permanent sovereignty of the Palestinian people in the Occupied Palestinian territory, including East Jerusalem, and of the Arab population in the occupied Syrian Golan region over their natural resources.

## **United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC)**

The Human Rights Council is an inter-governmental body within the United Nations system made up of 47 States responsible for the promotion and protection of all human rights around the globe. It can discuss all thematic human rights issues and situations that require its attention throughout the year. It meets at the UN Office at Geneva.

**Agenda:** Protection of the rights of racial and ethnic minorities in conflict zones.

## **Lok Sabha**

Lok Sabha is composed of representatives of the people chosen by direct election in India. The maximum strength of the House envisaged by the Constitution is 552. Broad responsibilities of the members of parliament of Lok Sabha are; To pass laws, ensure that the government performs its duties satisfactorily and represent the views and aspirations of the people of their constituency in the Parliament of India.

**Agenda:** Discourse on the implementation of National Population Register and National Register of Citizen.
